Re: Using Dart League Manager with Windows 95

To set up Windows 95 to work with Dart League Manager, follow the steps below.

- 1. Click Start button and open Windows Explorer.
- 2. Find Darts.exe file on your hard drive and select it by clicking on it once.
- 3. Go to File menu (or click your right mouse button) and select Properties.
- 4. Click on the Program tab at the top of the window.




Figure 1 - Advanced Program Settings

- 5. Click on the "Advanced..." button near the bottom of the window. You should then see a window titled "Advanced Program Settings." (Figure 1).
- 6. Select "MS-DOS mode" and then "Specify a new MS-DOS configuration."
- 7. In the top window, titled "CONFIG.SYS for MS-DOS mode," type the following lines (if there is any text already in the box, insert the lines at the bottom):

buffers=30,8 files=100

- 8. Click OK button to save your settings. Click OK again to close the Properties window.
- 9. Now your computer is ready to run DLM-DOS. Double click the Darts.exe file in the Explorer. Windows will have to go into a special DOS mode to run the program. Once you are finished working in DLM-DOS the computer will automatically go back to Windows 95.
